Information for new members

Below are some suggestions that will help you gain an insight into some of the etiquette of golf to help you enjoy your golf and time at the MGC

Dress Code

Neat and casual dress standards apply both on the course and in the clubhouse - collared shirt preferred, no singlets or tank tops, no thongs or attire with offensive pictures, wording or advertising.

Club Rooms

You are encouraged to come and use the clubroom facilities after finishing your round of golf for the announcement of competition results.

Competitions

- Tuesday 18 hole from 11.30am
- Thursday 9 hole stableford - tee off 9am
- Saturday 18 hole from 11.30am
- The competition fee is presently \$7:00 for 18 holes
- If you start but do not finish the Competition Fee is still payable
- Play in groups of 4 unless otherwise agreed
- Members are encouraged to vary tee-off times and to play with different players as much as possible.

Golf Etiquette

- You should not talk or move while another player is hitting.
- Avoid standing directly behind the player hitting the ball.
- Avoid stepping on another players line when putting (mark your ball)
- Keep up with the group in front and walk briskly between shots.
- Mark your score card on arrival at the next Tee Block.
- Do not leave your buggy in front of a green.
- Leave rake in the inside edge of the bunker facing the flagpole.
- Carry a sand bucket at all times.
- Repair all divot holes and pitch marks – it's a good habit to repair your own and others.
- Mobile Phones - Observe etiquette and don't let your mobile be a distraction for other players.

Volunteering

There is an expectation that members will volunteer a minimum of 10hrs over the 12 months of their membership as part of MGC culture.
